Guidelines for Trunk or Treat Vehicles

- Due to Covid this years trunk or treat is a drive-tru only experience. Our guests will not be stepping out of their cars. Families will drive pass your decorated and lit up car as they tune into 87.9 radio station where we will be playing fun Pixar movie theme music and giving direction. You will not give out candy from your trunk. Candy and popcorn will be given out at the circle drive along with a gospel activity book.
- You will need to provide your own decorations for your trunk. Make sure to **add lights!** If you need a plug adaptor for your car please let us know on your sign up. Be as creative as you'd like, your decorations don't only have to be in your trunk they can spill over to the parking space and all over your car. Keep in mind that decorations should be geared toward young children. No blood, devils, skeletons, gory, scary or creepy creatures.
- Remember parents have chosen to come to Holland First expecting it to be a safe and uplifting alternative to their neighborhoods or other venues.
- One adult must be present at each vehicle at all times.

- Set up will start at 5:30pm. Please arrive and check in by 6:00pm at the very latest. The children will start coming out to your cars by 6:30 so you must be ready by then. Plan to be here from 5:30pm - 9pm. The event is over by 8:30pm. It's our first time doing this event we aren't sure how it will all go. We ask that you wait by your cars until we are able to end everything.
- We will be using both parking areas by the trees and grass. You will see the cones and set up area. Upon arrival you will be shown where to park.
- We will not cancel if it is a fall drizzling evening, but we will cancel if it is a pouring rain evening.
